Subject: Regarding organizing Training Programmes for the Judges/ Magistrates of Subordinate Courts.

Sir,

“Jai Hind”

I have the honour submit that as directed it is proposed to reschedule the training programmes in respect of the Judges/ Magistrates of the Subordinate, so that the judicial time of the Judges/ Magistrates could be optimally utilized and the time spent in coming and going to the Academies i.e. National Judicial Academy and the State Judicial Academy, is curtailed to help eradicate huge arrears and pendency. In this behalf, it has been thought appropriate and expedient that the Capsule time be rescheduled to save the judicial time of all the Judges/ Magistrates visiting the Judicial Academy.

Therefore, it is most humbly submitted that henceforth all the training programmes for the Judges/Magistrates of Subordinate Courts shall be held on second Saturdays and Sundays or on two consecutive holidays (if any). The trainees shall be freed at around 2.00 p.m. on Sunday, enabling them to reach their respective destinations before next working day. This will also enable the trainee Judges/Magistrates to start from their stations on Fridays after completion of usual judicial work.

The rescheduling of training programmes, however, entails that on some occasions, more particularly on some second Saturdays, because of the National Lok Adalats, it will be difficult for all the Judges/ Magistrates to attend the training programmes in the Judicial Academy. In said eventuality, stations having multiple Judges may send a few Judges to the Academy for the training programmes and one or two Judges/ Magistrates can stay back to conduct the National Lok Adalats on their behalf and behalf of other Judges/ Magistrates. The stations having only one Judge/ Magistrate will have to be exempted from attending the training programme.



It is further submitted that henceforth all the training programmes for the Judges/Magistrates of Subordinate Judiciary shall be held on second Saturdays and Sundays or on two consecutive holidays only, till further orders.

Keeping in view the aforesaid, the training programmes from November, 2018 to June, 2019 have been rescheduled accordingly, as detailed below:
